#### **Exams**

#### **Goethe exams**

We offer the Goethe exams at levels A1-C2 twice a year. Information on dates, costs, registration deadlines, etc. can be found at vhs-lingen.de.

#### **German test for immigrants – Deutschtest für Zuwanderer (DTZ)**

The DTZ exam is the final exam after 600 hours of the integration course (modules 1-6) and certifies level B1. For external participants the VHS Lingen offers additional dates. Personal registrations are possible by appointment (0591 91202-110). Current dates can be found at vhs-lingen.de.

### Test "Living in Germany" – Test "Leben in Deutschland"

The orientation module of the integration course concludes with the test "Living in Germany". For external participants, the VHS Lingen offers additional dates. Personal registrations are possible by appointment (0591 91202-110). Current dates can be found at vhslingen.de.

### German test for profession - Deutschtest für den Beruf (DTB)

The DTB examination marks the end of the professional language course and certifies knowledge at the targeted level.

### Citizenship test – Einbürgerungstest

For the proof of knowledge of the legal and social order and living conditions in Germany, a naturalization test can be taken at the VHS Lingen. This proof is required for naturalization in Germany. Personal registrations are possible by appointment (0591 91202-110). To register, please bring 35.00 euros in cash and your ID. Current dates can be found at vhs-lingen.de.



### **FAQs**

### What is the difference between an integration course and a German course open to everyone?

The integration course is funded by the Federal Office for Migration and Refugees and completes up to level B1. German courses that are open to everyone must be paid for by the participants themselves. They are available from A1 to C2.

### Who is allowed to attend an integration course?

Anyone who receives an authorization or obligation may attend an integration course. You can get the relevant document from the Foreigners' Office, the Social Welfare Office or the Employment Office.

I don't speak German yet. Do I still have to take a placement test? Yes, everyone has to take a placement test.

#### Do I get a ticket for the trip to the integration course?

If you do not have to pay contributions for the integration course and live more than 3 km from the place of instruction, you can apply for a travel allowance.

## Do I have to pay the course fees for German courses, which are open to everyone, immediately or is payment in monthly installments possible?

The course fees can be paid in three installments if you agree to a direct debit. Otherwise, the entire course fee is due at the start of the course.

### Is there a reduction in the course fee for German courses that are open to everyone?

No. The courses are not discountable.

### In the German test for immigrants I only achieved the result A2. How can I repeat?

A request for 300 retake hours must be submitted. Then you can repeat the exam.

### Do you have courses with childcare?

No, unfortunately we do not currently have any courses with childcare.


